



Documents Required to Apply for School Certificate Equivalency

- For Qatari Students: Copy of (valid) Qatar Identification Card (QID).
- For Non-Qatari Students: Copy of Passport + Copy of (valid) Qatar Identification Card (QID).

Academic Requirements:

First: Requirements for the equivalency of Grade 1 to Grades 12 certificates (passing to a higher grade):

Certified/attested end of year transcripts for the previous two grades must be attached (Example: A student wants to enroll into Grade 9, he/she must provide end of year transcripts for Grades 7 and 8).

Second: Requirements for the equivalency of certificates of students who have graduated from high school (pre-university stage):

Graduates of the General Secondary School	Holders of the British General Certificate of Secondary Education	Graduates of the International Baccalaureate (IB)
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certified/attested end of year transcripts for the previous three school years.• Secondary school graduation certificate (for countries issuing this certificate).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Passing five (at least) 'O-Level' subjects of the GCSE, and (at least) two (A-Level) subjects or advanced level (AS) subjects.• Five of the subjects taught to the student must be in conformity with the curriculum subjects prescribed in the Qatari General Secondary Certificate.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The student must have completed six subjects, at least three of which are Higher Level (HL), and at least three subjects are Standard level (SL).• CAS, TOK and EE scores are not counted in the percentage score.• The student's should score no less than 24 points.• Furnish the International Baccalaureate certificate along with the school certificate.
